## **“Surviving the Interagency Monster: Secrets of Success No Insider Will Tell You”**

Defeating transnational crime and terrorism requires more than just understanding and taking down terrorist, criminal, and their overlapping networks. It also requires slaying or co-opting other wily enemies: competing government agencies, clashing workforce cultures, and uncooperative foreign partners. After 20 years as an observant outsider of interagency and multinational efforts in this area, Priest will deconstruct what she has seen and explain how one can not only survive but be successful in the belly of the bureaucratic beast. The lessons are applicable to university and think-tank work as well.
