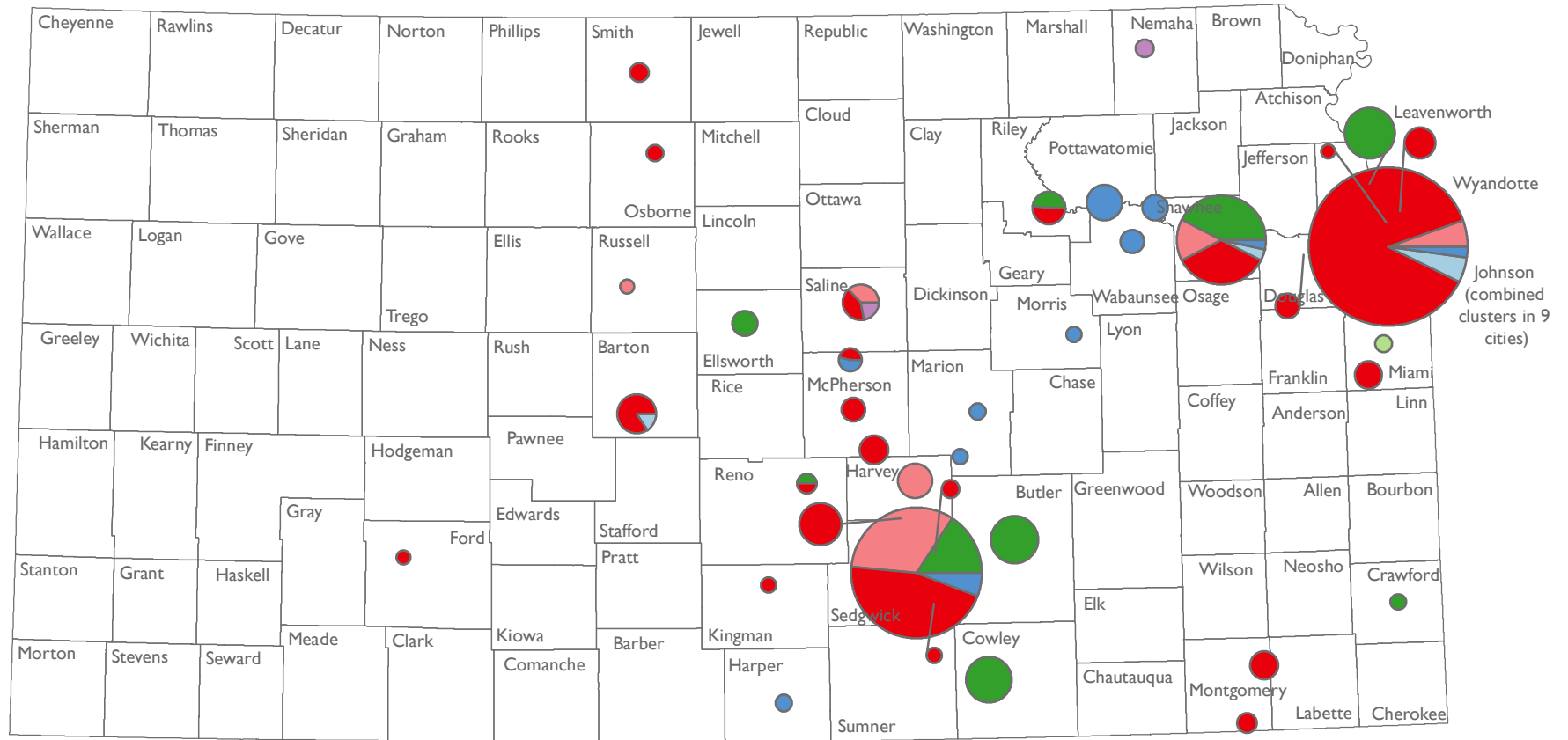


COVID-19 Clusters in Kansas, by City of Facility as of January 12, 2022
